EDPL SUMMER SEASON 2022-23

- **Summer Team Applications Close – Monday 26th September**
- **Summer Season 2022-23 Commences – Either Tuesday 11th or 18th October**

INFORMATION NOTES FOR SUMMER TEAM CAPTAINS AND CLUBS

- 1) **The current EDPL Constitution and By-laws** are applicable. These are on the EDPL Website.
- 2) **The current “World Rules”** as on the EDPL Website apply.
- 3) **Monthly invoices will be issued to each club** Invoices will be on a per club basis, not per team, but each team will be itemized on the invoice. Payment of all invoices is required within 14 days of issue date.
- 4) **Team Application Forms and Player Registrations**
 - a) Summer Season will run similar to Winter Season, after week 1 has been played...
Eg: clubs with multiple Summer teams start as per team submitted but then can move players between teams/divisions as per Winter. Clearances between clubs during the Summer Season ARE permitted.
 - b) **Team Application Form** Clubs must submit Teams on Official Form by **Monday 26th September**
 - c) **Player Registration Form** – not required if last played summer in 2019-2020 for same club.
(as 2019-2020 is the most recent previous EDPL Summer Season where players registered with club)
 - d) **Clearances** are required for any player who wishes to join a summer team that is not from the same club that they previously played summer for. (Summer & Winter season clearances are totally separate, Clearances are Summer to Summer club, & Winter to Winter club).
 - e) All teams are encouraged to submit a Team Name. (**Do not use offensive language**).
 - f) **No team submitted can be more than 112.2 points in total** (total value of the top 6 players when ordered from highest to lowest point value, **USING THE NEW 2023 PLAYER POINT VALUES**).
- 5) **DIVISION INFO & POINTS FOR THIS SUMMER**

NOTE: WE WILL BE USING THE NEW 2023 WINTER PLAYER POINT VALUES, WHICH WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE EDPL WEBSITE AFTER 2022 WINTER STATS ARE COMPLETED.

6) TEAM HANDICAPS – will be used this Summer Season

- a) In a match, each teams' players points will be added up to determine a team points total. The highest 5 or 6 players points in the match will be added to get the maximum team points total. The difference between the two teams' points totals to be calculated (eg $111.8 - 96.2 = 15.6$ pts lower)
- b) **HANDICAPS:**
1st & 2nd Div = 1 frame per 5pts difference. 3rd & 4th Div = 1 frame per 4pts difference
1 frame to be added to lower points team, as per above (eg.. 1st Div $111.8 - 96.2 = 15.6$ pts lower. Therefore, 3 more "bonus" frames would be added to the lower pts team score total, for results/ladders)

7) Scoresheets

- a) Scoresheets will be available on the EDPL website for each division.
- b) **Home team is responsible to enter the match scores into the EDPL website after the match, prior to 10:00am Wednesday.** (note that fines apply if you do not enter scores on the website).
- c) **Scoresheet to be lodged to EDPL office** by 4:00pm on Friday after the match (original/copy/email). Most captains take a photo of the scoresheet with their phone, and email to the office after the match.

8) Dress Code

The current EDPL dress-code as stated in the By-Laws is applicable in full and without any modification (unless an authorized letter from EDPL Executive allows a dress-code exemption).

9) Tables Three (3) tables should be utilized wherever possible (2 tables allowed, if absolutely necessary).

10) Captains being "Called-in"

Captains may be "called-in" once per frame in all Divs other than 1st Div where NO call-ins are permitted.

11) Umpiring

Umpires must be utilized during the match, with each team umpiring equal number of frames/rounds.

12) Captains Responsibility

- a) Captains of summer teams must be accredited! As per By-Law 8.18...
- b) All team captains are responsible for their players conduct and dress.
- c) Remember that venues have the right to refuse entry to any player or to eject any player from their premise. Do not put yourself, or any of your team members, in the position of being excluded from any venue for whatever reason.
- d) EDPL Executive Committee will discipline severely any member who brings the League's reputation into disrepute or in any way affects its standing with any venue that sponsors a club of the league.
- e) Any problem or query that you may have should be referred to the EDPL office as soon as it is possible. Complaints must be submitted within 24 hours of match night.
- f) Make sure all money collected is recorded (from who & how much) and passed to the appropriate person within your club. You don't want any problems arising later in the season.
