"New" Player Point Matrix - Winter 2026

Important: This matrix applies only to new players that **DO NOT** have an existing point value.

Categorisation applies based on the new player's achievements as at the starting date of EDPL Winter Season 2026

"New Player" Juniors (14-17 years old): Points value for incoming "New Player" Juniors to be assessed as per current "New Player Matrix", and **then apply a 0.7 factor** to determine their true points given their reduced years of experience and playing against well established players.

Notes:

1. The EDPL Executive have the power to over-ride any new player values listed above (refer By-law 3.1.8)
2. If a player already has a listed point value on the EDPL website, this Matrix is irrelevant and the player will retain the value as listed on the website
3. If you are not sure whether a particular tournament is classified as a "major money tournament", check with the EDPL Office prior to the player playing.
4. Any player who fits any of the criteria above, will retain the appropriate point value regardless of which Division they play on any given night
5. Any players who **do not** meet **any** of the criteria in this matrix will assume the default 'new player point value assigned to Div they play on any given night.
